Congress is moving forward this week with a short-term Continuing Resolution (CR) that would fund the FAA until December. The bipartisan effort could be voted on this Wednesday in the House and then move to the Senate for a vote before the deadline. This is a positive development, but NATCA will continue to follow the progress and update you on the status of the efforts to avoid a government shutdown.
