We are evaluating the various Executive Orders (EO) and Presidential Memoranda (PM) issued by President Trump.

At this time, we do not have a definitive answer if the hiring freeze PM affects air traffic control hiring, or how the FAA intends to address the PM on remote workers returning to in-person work. We will keep you up to date on these important subjects as information becomes available.
