Last night, NATCA became aware of the Executive Order titled, “Exclusions from Federal Labor-Management Relations Programs.” NATCA leadership and staff have been reviewing it. We are analyzing its effects on NATCA’s members and our established collective bargaining relationships in both the Federal Aviation Administration and Department of Defense. As that analysis progresses, we will share it you.

The United States National Airspace System is the most complex in the world. NATCA’s members are the reason it is the safest and most efficient in the world. Our long-term collaborative relationship with the FAA on procedures and modernization makes the system safer for the American flying public and delivers new programs faster and more cost-effectively for the American taxpayer. NATCA remains committed to working with Secretary Duffy to fully staff the air traffic control system by hiring and training the next generation of air traffic controllers, retaining experienced air traffic controllers, and modernizing the air traffic control system.
